### Share your Web drive . . .

. . . in a secure group setting. You have quite a few choices if you want to create a shared data store over the Internet. Michael Ryan, CEO of South River Technologies Inc. in Annapolis, Md., wants you to consider SRT's GroupDrive 5.0 when it ships this summer. GroupDrive, which is often used by businesses with far-flung workers who need to share data, provides support for multi-factor authentication, encryption of stored files and stronger scrambling of data while it's in transit, Ryan says. It also includes file locking so that when someone is working on a file, other users can only read it. Pricing starts at \$5,500 for 100 users.
