Campus-Wide Deployment of SRT's GroupDrive Product Gives Students and Faculty Ubiquitous Campus-Wide Access to File Storage and Collaboration Technology

ANNAPOLIS, Md.—August 7, 2007—South River Technologies, Inc., an innovator in secure file transfer and collaboration software, today announced that its GroupDrive software has been licensed to the University of Portland. With the campus wide installation of GroupDrive complete, students and faculty recently began securely collaborating and sharing files over the Internet, eliminating the need to use traditional forms of unsecured and inefficient file transfer such as email.

Utilizing GroupDrive accessibility campus-wide, University of Portland students are for the first time able to file share and collaborate on class projects whether they are on or off campus. Professors can communicate with fellow faculty members and also post class assignments in specific GroupDrive files that are accessible by the entire class or by permission, based on the need of the student.

Many departments within the administration offices are experiencing the power of GroupDrive to improve start-to-finish times on projects, including administrators working in the marketing office. Prior to GroupDrive, marketing department staff members working with outside vendors on graphic intensive publications or marketing collateral would save new files on CD-ROMs and then have a courier deliver them across the city or overnight, depending on the location of the vendor. Not only was this process expensive, but it created a lengthy lag time between the start and finish of projects. Today, utilizing GroupDrive, marketing department employees can securely share files with vendors over the Internet, eliminating the entire CD-ROM process and speeding completion of projects.

In addition to university marketers, students and faculty members are utilizing the benefits of GroupDrive first hand. For example, the College of Arts & Sciences currently

has a professor in Europe studying cathedrals on a grant given to the university. In the past, one or two days worth of the professor's research and photos would have been saved on CD-ROMs and sent back to the university via overnight courier. Similar to the experience within the marketing department, courier costs were expensive and resulted in a lag time in delivery and downloading of files for students. Now, students can instantly access files once the professor saves them on GroupDrive.
